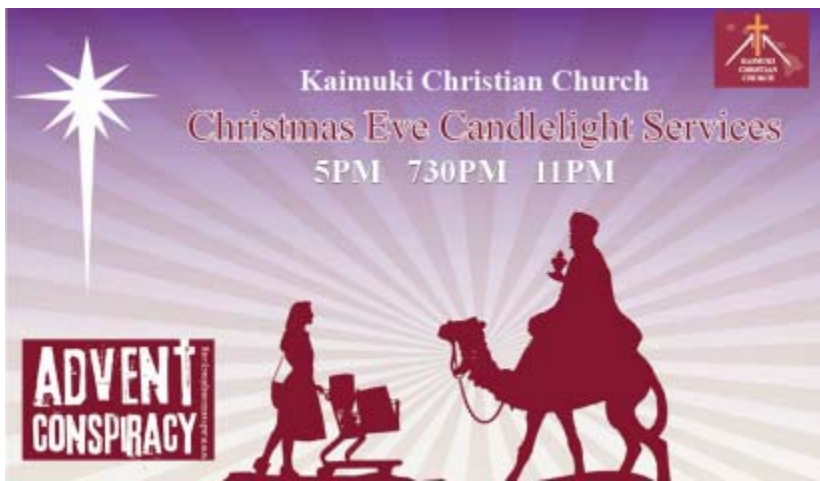
Chapel Specials Thursday, December 17
